

## **Major Stephen Mark Badger**

Major (US Army) Stephen Mark Badger, age 37, died October 27, 1995, at Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

Born December 13, 1957, in Salt Lake City, Utah, a son of William Burton and Maurine Romney Badger. Stephen attended Salt Lake elementary schools, Clayton Jr. High, Highland High School and graduated from BYU. He joined the ROTC at Highland High, served in the National Guard, and graduated from BYU ROTC as a 2nd Lt. in 1985.
