

CSM DOUG RUSSELL AWARD

***Nominations for the 2014 Award accepted 1 November – 31 December 2014;
Announcement of 2014 winner will be NLT 1 February 2015.***

The CSM Doug Russell Award was established in 2000 to recognize the outstanding achievements of Soldiers within or on behalf of the Military Intelligence Community. To be eligible, a candidate must be a Military Intelligence Soldier in the rank of Sergeant (E-5) or below in the Active Army, Army Reserve or National Guard. While it is not mandatory that the candidate hold an MI Military Occupational Specialty (MOS), he/she must have performed actions that directly contribute to the MI Corps. The candidate must be fully eligible for reenlistment.

Nominations will be accepted only for individual Soldiers (no unit or group nominations), and must not be self-nominated. There can be only one nomination per year from each of the following:

- MI Group, Brigade, or Battalion
- Brigade Troop/Support Battalions within a Maneuver Division
- MI Support Elements (G2/Brigade S2/Battalion S2) within a Maneuver Division
- DCSINT-oriented organizations (EAC units and positions not formally assigned to a specific MI Group/Brigade/Battalion)
