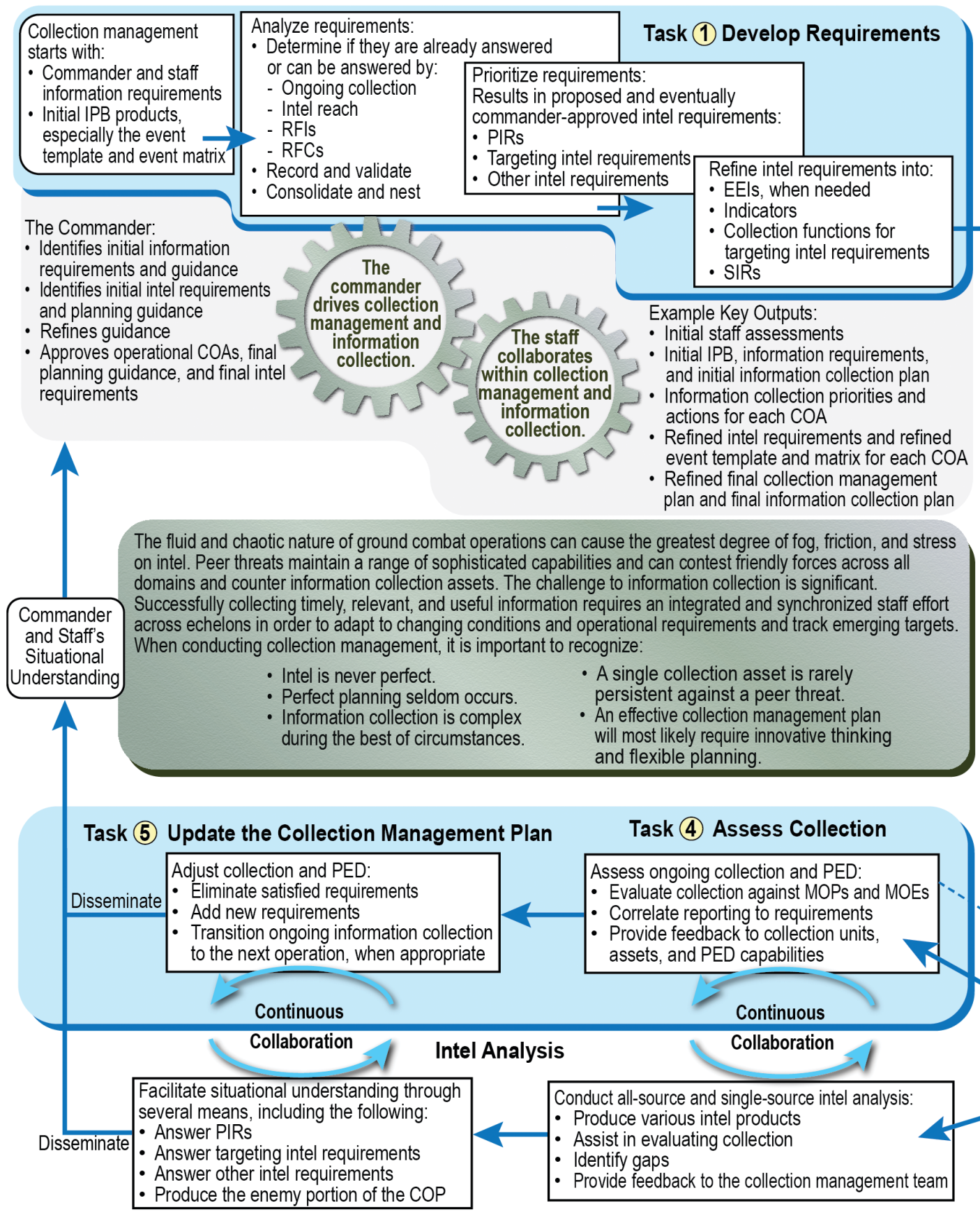


ATP 2-01, Collection Management Logic Chart

Develop a collection strategy:

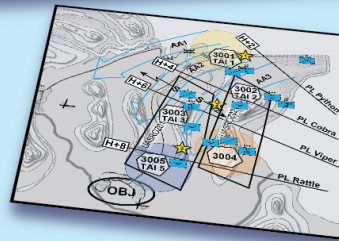
- Match collection assets to SIRs

Task ③ Support Tasking and Directing

Support the operations staff in completing the information collection plan:

- Portions of the base order
- Portions of Annex B (Intel)
- Annex L (Information Collection)

The unit publishes and disseminates a WARNORD, FRAGORD, or OPORD with Annex L (Information Collection) to start information collection.

In conjunction with the operations staff in the current operations cell:

- Maintain synchronization
- Develop new requirements
- Recommend adjustments to/ retaskings of collection assets

Continuous Communications and Feedback, Ensuring Effective Collection

Collection assets prepare for collection, conduct collection, and report:

- Reconnaissance assets
- Surveillance assets
- Intel operations assets
- Security operations assets

Collection unit, control element (when appropriate), and PED element:

- Receive order
- Task specific collection assets
